### RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR STUDENT BEHAVIOR

Students in the HealthQuest Camp must observe College policies as set forth below and in other College publications. Students who violate these rules and/or who behave in an unsafe or reckless manner while on or off College property will be held responsible for their actions.

**A violation of any of the following rules and regulations may be the cause for disciplinary action, including possible immediate dismissal from the program without a refund.**

- Possession and/or use of alcohol or illegal drugs is prohibited. *We follow a zero tolerance policy and strictly enforce this policy. Students who are found responsible for an alcohol or drug violation will be immediately dismissed from the program without a refund.*
- Acts of sexual harassment will not be tolerated. Exchanging sexually-charged gestures, noises, remarks, jokes or comments about an individual's sexuality are prohibited. Displaying or broadcasting inappropriate images, text, or sound (such as pictures, posters, graffiti, text messages, video footage or other media is prohibited. *Sexual harassment may take a variety of forms and refers to a broad spectrum of conduct. We follow a zero tolerance policy. Students who are found to be in violation of this policy will be immediately dismissed from the program without a refund.*
- Any action or situation involving verbal, mental, or physical assault and/or abuse, including harassment, intimidation, bully, name-calling, or other conduct that recklessly or intentionally endangers or threatens the health, safety, or welfare of any person is prohibited. Intentional damage to other students' and/or College property is prohibited.
- Students must be in their residence hall by building curfew: 11:00 p.m. Residence halls will be locked at all times.
- Quiet hours must be observed from 10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. Disruptive, excessively noisy or indecent conduct is cause for disciplinary action.
- Co-educational (male/female) visitation within a residence hall other than in common areas (lounge, study room, and balconies) is prohibited from two hours after building curfew until 7:00 a.m. the next morning. However, co-educational visitation in a residence hall room requires an open door.
- Students are required to check-in each day at building curfew. Students are required to be on time for all required program activities and to follow the policies of their instructors. During non-academic portions of the day, students are expected to be on campus.
- The possession or use of firearms, weapons, fireworks, candles, and incense are prohibited. (candles and incense are fire hazards) No smoking is allowed in any building on the Ithaca College Campus. Students may not have vehicles on campus during the program. Pets are not allowed.
